This is the 3rd (and final) Directive (DIR) in a series of three for John Deere "H" tractors. The first was DIR214 in 1939 for Model H, then DIR248 in 1940 for Models H & HN, and finally DIR276 in 1943 for all four configurations, Models H, HN, HNH and HWH.



Title = INSTRUCTIONS and PARTS LIST (IPL for short).

This is the ORIGINAL & VERY BEST Owner's/Operator's Manual for John Deere Models "H", "HN", "HNH" and "HWH" tractors.

This manual looks back on all variations, and covers your tractor like a blanket! Its content includes:

**Operating instructions** -- starting, running and stopping the engine and stopping the tractor; servicing instructions.

**Periodic Maintenance** -- periodic servicing of filters and breathers, lubricating schedules, capacities and oil weights in crankcase, main case

and hydraulic lift – also outlines special lubrication requirements depending on tractor use.

**Adjustments and repairs** – contains all operator-level adjustments from front wheels to drawbar, belt pulley, pulley brake, camshaft, carburetor, clutch, differential, brakes, starting & lighting equipment, shaft end-play here and there, and much more.

**Illustrations** – This manual is loaded with pictorial illustrations of all controls, adjustments, lubrication level-check and entry points, and repair techniques.
