2. Introducing a new, two-part tapered roller bearing replacement for the traditional & original three-part ball bearing by New Departure, ND Part number 909021.



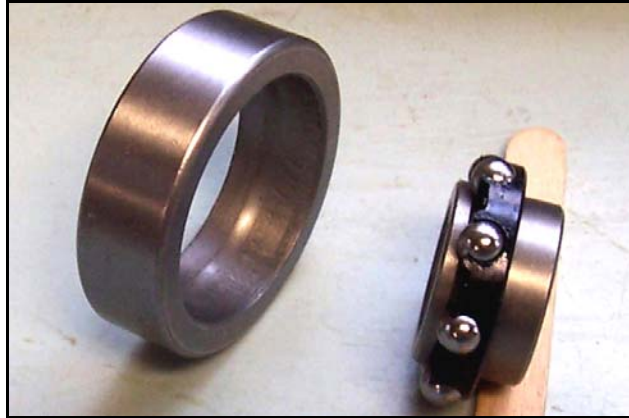
Photo of Tapered Roller Bearing – No Free/Floating Parts!



Comparison!

Original configuration by New Departure versus the new two-part roller bearing.

Advantages – Besides longer life, with a two-piece bearing – there's no bearing cage falling out of position during build-up. This happens to many first-timers and also to seniors – it's frustrating! No Floaters here!



Here we have a photo of Deere P/N JD7150 being sold as a replacement for the Original configuration – now being sold for roughly **\$125 (June 2010)** at the John Deere Parts Counter.

The black thingee you see is a kind of rubber-like jell and if you don't have near perfect alignment during integration, you will be on your hands & knees in search of bearing balls!

But the worst is that you may not realize (during integration) that parts of the bearing were lost, and at start-up, there goes your fan drive & pinion gears. It only takes a few minutes!
